All Saints day, called All Hallows day is celebrated on November 1st

The Department of Catechesis of the Syro Malabar Eparchy of St. Thomas the Apostle Melbourne is encouraging the catechism students and young adults up to the age 21 to celebrate the day as suggested below.

Dress up like a saint and prepare a short video

1. Parents are to complete the below registration and sign n media consent permitting their child to participate in the program before 16th October.

- 2. Choose any of the saints listed in this guideline.
- 3. Dress up in costumes so that the visual expresses the chosen saint.
- 4. Prepare 30 seconds to 90 seconds video of the child in *saint's costume* (Should not exceed two minutes)
- 5. General sample format:
- "I am (name) from Grade ____ of St Alphonsa Sunday school Parramatta. I want to be Holy and become a saint, like (example, Mary Mackillop). I want to share with you a famous quote from her; "Never see a need without doing something about it." Remember, we are all called to be saints. (show a picture of your saint)
- 6. Submit good quality videos entries to the department of Catechesis from <u>21st to 31st</u> October 2024

Note: The costume chosen should be appropriate and an example of Holiness

Tips for making Video

Record in landscape mode
Use plenty of light, use a clean background
Crisp & clear, avoid shaky footage

Avoid anything related to your personal information in the video like address or car number or the like.
