Saint Costume Video Guidelines

- **2.** Choose a Saint: Select any saint listed in this guideline.
- **3. Dress Up**: Wear a costume that visually represents your chosen saint. Be creative and respectful in your portrayal.

4. Record Your Video

Prepare a short video of the child dressed as the saint.

Duration: 30 to 90 seconds (must not exceed 90 seconds)

Ensure good lighting and clear audio for best quality.

5. Sample Script

Here's an example you can follow:

"I am (Name) from Grade ____ of St Alphonsa Forane Parish, Parramatta. I want to be holy and become a saint, like (Saint's Name). I want to share with you a famous quote from them: '(Insert quote).' Remember, we are all called to be saints." (Show a picture of the saint at the end)

6. Submission date:

Please submit your video entry to the Department of Catechesis before **31st October 2025**

Note: Costumes should be modest, respectful, and reflect the holiness and virtues of the chosen saint.

Tips for creating Video

- Record in landscape mode for a wider, more professional look.
- Use plenty of light and choose a clean, uncluttered background to keep the focus on the child.
- Ensure the video is crisp and clear—avoid shaky footage.
- Do not include any personal information such as your home address, car number plates, or other identifiable details.
